Target> To give students opportunities to develop their English abilities through the exploration and discussion of a variety of themes. Students will develop their real-life communicative skills while expanding their vocabulary, grammatical ability, reading ability and fluency. Various media forms will be used in this class. Practice in the four skills reading, writing, listening and speaking will be provided during class and through homework.

Outline) English speech and presentation Notes: 1. Students are expected to speak and write only in English during class. They are expected to work not only in class, but outside of class as well. Homework is required, and they are expected to complete it even if they are absent from class. 2. The following class schedule is tentative and only shows the general contents which will be adjusted due to student input. There may be other modifications based on class size and other factors.
