problem or current event to work with during the semester. With his or her social problem, the student will keep up with the news through newspapers, magazine and internet articles, internet blogs, or TV and movie documentary and films.

- Goal ① 【知識・理解】 Students will learn how to use different forms of media for pursuing their studies. ② 【汎用的技能】 Students will have a better command of academic reading and discussion skills. ③ 【態度・志向性】 Students will gain confidence in using academic readings and discussions and not shy away from opportunities to gather information in English. ④ 【統合的な学習経験と 創造的思考力】 Students will become an expert in a social issue and gain the motivation to follow up on the issue from a disciplinary boundary as well.
- Schedule》第1回:needs analysis and deciding a topic 第2回:finding information on your topic 第3回:learning how to read articles 第4回:learning to write and take notes 第5回:learning to present and discuss 第6~9回:discussing readings and writings 第10回:reflection of topic 第11~14回:discussing readings and writings 第15回:final presentations and report submission 第16回: final presentations and reflection
- **Evaluation Criteria** Assessment will be based on reading and writing homework, class discussions, final presentations and reports. Teacher-student and student-student communication in class will be conducted in English. Students are recommended to think about or even choose a social problem before attending the first class.
